Dear Parent and Carers,

What a brilliant week we have had in school. Having all of the Stockland Green family back together again has been wonderful. I appreciate we aren't truly back together in the usual sense with the new measures that are in place, but just having us all in the same space is something I won't take for granted. It's also so good to know that our local community doesn't take us for granted. We have had numerous messages of goodwill and support this week for the work we do, a fact supported by our waiting lists for Years 7 and 8 alone stretching to over 300, suggesting our school is extremely well regarded in the local community, a community we're so proud to serve.

Our students have approached their return with maturity and I thank them for that. They understand the need for the measures in place to ensure the safety of us all in the building, but also for our families when we go home. The guidance on gatherings changes on Monday as I am sure you are aware, so please encourage your children not to congregate before or after school. I have added the start and exit timetable at the bottom of the letter as a reminder, but please do tell your children not to arrive to their allocated gate until the correct time and then to go straight home at the end of the day.

As of Monday 14th September, our school detention system will be back in operation. All detentions will be for 30 minutes currently and they will be sat in year groups so students from different bubbles will not mix. You will be notified of any detention via text as per our school policy. Students will exit school via the same gate they arrived at. I have added the detention exit times to the entry and exit timetable which is below.

Please do remind your children to have their face covering with them every day and to have some hand sanitiser. Also that on a PE day students are not permitted to wear branded jumpers or jackets. They can wear the school zip up top or their school jumper. I appreciate your support with this as this is the expected uniform for any PE day.

For us all a full week in school has been a bit of a shock to the system. I do hope that our school community take time this weekend for self-care and to support wellbeing. It's so important to have a balance in life of work and play, so I do hope that your children get an opportunity to rest and unwind after such a positive week in school.
